If you are awarded APL for a specific course you will be exempt from taking this course. It means you are considered to have completed the course for the purposes of progression within the programme. The mark obtained for a qualification for which APL has been awarded will not be carried forward to your record and will not contribute towards the award.

The University reserves the right not to award APL if the qualification of the respective professional body or institution changes after the publication of this list.

The deadline to apply for APL to be considered for the upcoming academic year is **1 October**.

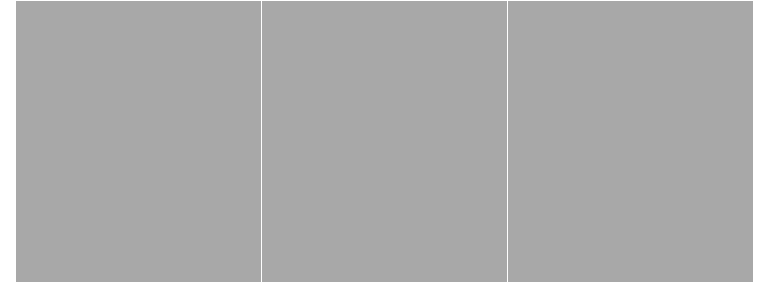
